Five star rating for ‘Scores on the doors’

A five star rating has just been awarded to both of the catering outlets managed by The Oxford Science Park.

Both the Magdalen Centre Cafe and Sadler Brasserie restaurant have gained the maximum five stars in Oxford City Council’s recent ‘Scores on the doors’ inspection.

The scheme awards marks under the headings of; ‘Confidence in management’, ‘Hygiene and safety’ and ‘Structural’. Marks are aggregated to give the overall Food hygiene rating expressed on a scale of 0 to 5 stars.

Food and Beverage manager Julien Such commented:

“The whole catering team (Park-Life-Style) at the Science Park work exceptionally hard to provide a range of good quality, freshly prepared food for breakfasts, lunches, events and business meetings.
